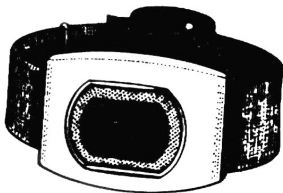

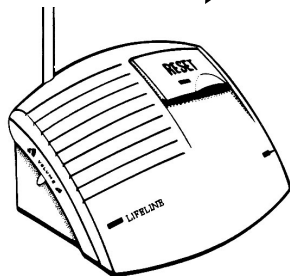
What is Lifeline?

Lifeline is an easy to use personal response service that ensures older adults living at home get quick assistance whenever it is needed—24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

Why do I need Lifeline?

Life is unpredictable. An unexpected fall or medical emergency could threaten your future health if help is delayed.

It is simple to use.

Whenever you need help, one press of your lightweight, waterproof help button activates a small in-home unit called a communicator. It puts you in touch with a caring Lifeline Monitor who talks to you to find out what kind of help you need.

He or she will call one of your friends, neighbors or relatives—“responders” who will come to your home to check on you. If you need more professional help, your monitor will call for it immediately.

And if you press you button and can't speak, your Lifeline monitor knows exactly what to do.



Who responds when I press my button?

The Lifeline Monitor has instant access to your pertinent health history and personal profile on the computer screen.

How much does it cost?

You are not required to buy any equipment or make a long-term commitment. Monthly rental fee is \$31.00.

Installation fees are:

- In or within twenty miles of Washington-\$40.
- More than twenty miles outside of Washington-\$50.
